

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (CORE)

Overview of the course

As part of the core curriculum, all students will undertake a Personal Development Programme. This will build upon their prior studies in Religious Studies during Key Stage Three and will provide an opportunity for students to consider key issues and questions relating to themselves, as well as to the broader community and world of which they are part.

Course content

Teaching of this course will be delivered through the following themes

- Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHEE)
- Citizenship
- Philosophy and Morality
- Relationships Education
- Careers Education

How you will be assessed

- There is no formal assessment of this course.
- Students will have a specific focus of their studies throughout each theme, and will work with their teachers on building a record of their personal development and skills developed throughout this course.

Post-16 options available

Some of the themes covered will be continued with Religious Studies at A level, which is currently available in The Sandon Sixth Form. Equally, the skills developed throughout this course will be beneficial regardless of any post-16 choices.
