<b>Curriculum and Well Being Support for 2020/21</b>	
One to one support will be offered on a priority basis to assist students in reaching their potential. We again will plan a mentoring programme which offers students both academic and behaviour support, also workshops, such as reading and spelling to assist in providing strategies for achieving in school. We offer strategies to support students during any period of self isolation due to the pandemic, which included provision of work books, wellbeing support and welfare.
